### Venue

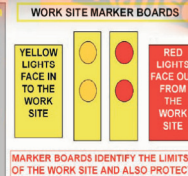
Our modern training centre in Gateshead or we can arrange training at a location to suit your needs



When a possession has been given by the signaller, the PICOP (Person In Charge Of Possession) will arrange with the signaller to take possession of the line to protect the work which will take place.

The PICOP will position the Possession Limit Boards at the limits of the possession.

Four Possession Limit Boards will be placed in the four quadrants of the work site (the middle of each quadrant).
