### Other information

- Following successful completion of the course Railsafe Training will register your certification with the NCCA
- Re-certification is required every two years and consists of a two day classroom based course and assessment

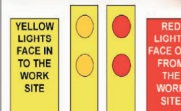
When the PICOP (Person In Charge Of Possession) has been given possession time the PICOP (Person In Charge Of Possession) will contact the signaller to take possession of the line to protect the work which will take place.

The PICOP will position the Possession Limit Boards at the limits of the work.

Yellow Possession Limit Boards will be placed in the four corners of the work site area.
